Dear Parents/Carers,

In Year 4, we are studying the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings as part of our 'Invaders and Settlers' topic. In order to bring our topic to life, we have arranged for the children to be involved in some exciting workshops which will provide opportunity for the children to experience what life was like in the periods being studied. The details of the workshops are as follows:

On Monday 4th February – Class 4KH and Class 4SM , and on Tuesday 5th February – Class 4DM and Class 4ZH will be engaging in the 'hands-on' Viking workshop led by staff from North Lincolnshire Museum Learning Service. The workshop is called 'Lindsey Goes Berserk' and in the workshop, the children will meet Helga the Viking lady as well as being able to handle real and replica artefacts used in Viking times.

On Thursday 7th February, all classes will engage in a further workshop 'A Taste of History' in which they will make a variety of Viking style dishes before sampling them.

To keep costs low, all workshops have been organised to take place on school premises, so the children will need to wear uniform and arrive to school at the usual time on the days of their workshops.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £6.00 towards the cost of the workshops by Wednesday 23rd January (at the latest). School is subsidising part of the cost of the services that are to be offered, so it is important for us to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions, it will not be possible for the workshops to take place and they will be cancelled.
