Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our science topic on living things and their habitats, we have arranged for Year 5 pupils to visit Woodside Wildlife Park where they will meet a variety of animals from different habitats and will also have the opportunity to walk around the park to learn about the magnificent animals which reside there.

Children are required to wear uniform for this trip, however, we recommend that children bring lots of additional layers and waterproofs as they will be outside for the majority of the day. Children will also need other outerwear such as gloves and hats; comfy, water-proof shoes; and an appropriate bag to carry their pack-up in.

Pupils will need a packed lunch on the day. If your child receives free school meals, then a packed lunch will be provided. No glass bottles or fizzy drinks please.

If your child has an inhaler they must carry this at all times. Please ensure the school has up-to-date information about any medical needs your child has. The trip will take place within the usual school hours on **Wednesday 16th October**.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £11 towards the cost of the trip by Friday 11th October. **This will be set up via ParentPay once we have received reply slips. Please do NOT send cash. It is important for us to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions it will not be possible for the trip to take place and it will be cancelled.**
